INTRODUCTION TO WING SHOOTING CLINIC 2017

For Boys or Girls between the ages of 12 to 16 (not including 16)

The Dr. Donald Skinner Memorial Wing Shooting Clinic is annually held each Fall season at Hanscome Outdoor Adventures in California Settlement, NB.

This program is offered at no cost to the participants and Includes transportation from Fredericton to California Settlement and return – also Included is food and accommodation's + ammunition.

Participants will receive training in "Field Safety", proper preparation and processing of harvested game birds, general duties associated with camp life and respect for their peers and the Sporting Tradition.

Attendees will hunt pheasants, accompanied by a licensed Guide over pointing dogs. All youths will have a chance to win a 20ga shotgun (with their parents' permission.)

Participants are encouraged to bring their own shot gun (no semi auto or pumps are allowed for safety reasons.) When necessary, shotguns can be supplied.
